Quality Care

We have programs available for all children ages 6 weeks thru 12 years. All programs offered are vitally important to a child's physical, social, emotional, and cognitive development. The staff in each classroom creates an environment, including developmentally appropriate activities, to nurture each child's individual development.

Hours of Operation

6 am to 5:45 pm—Monday through Friday. We are always open year round Monday-Friday, even on bad weather days and school breaks! (Closed on Major Holidays) Drop in care is also available with pre-registration.

Nutritious Meals Served Daily

Breakfast, lunch and afternoon snack are prepared on site and offered to all children enrolled in the Rainbow program, this includes baby food and formula. All meals meet the State of Wisconsin DPI Food Program guidelines and are prepared with the ages of all children in mind. All Menus are posted weekly.

State Licensed

Rainbow Childcare is licensed by the state of Wisconsin for 207 children between the ages of 6 weeks through 12 years. All Rainbow staff is trained in Early Childhood Education, CPR, and First Aid, in order to provide a safe, caring and friendly environment for your child.

Infants & Toddlers—Tots (6wks—2 1/2 yr)

Preschool (Ages 2 1/2—5 years)

4 Kindergarten (4 yr)

Before & After School (5 –12 yrs)

Summer Camp (School Age Children)

A loving a warm environment for all students. Teachers are aware of the developmental stages of learning that is appropriate to each age group. Social skills, problem solving, sharing and manners are emphasized. In older children teachers prepare the student for reading readiness, math, science and motor development, all while having fun!

Parent Involvement

We invite and encourage parent involvement at Rainbow Childcare. Parents are welcome any time to feed or just cuddle their babies. Other parents may visit at any time and have an open invitation to join us for lunch. There are many activities held throughout the year in which parents are invited to participate.
